Results of first call for Marie Curie Industry-Academia Partnerships and Pathways Fellowships

Some 103 proposals were submitted in response to the first Marie Curie Industry-Academia Partnerships and Pathways Fellowships (IAPP) call of the Seventh Framework Programme (FP7), which closed on 31 May. Having passed the first phase of evaluation, 41 project proposals will now be put forward for a second round of evaluation. The projects most eligible for funding will be those that involve the transfer of technology and know-how between industry and the academia.

With a total budget of €38.5 million, the call seeks to open and foster dynamic pathways between public research organisations and private commercial enterprises, including in particular small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs).

FP7 call for proposals: Capacities programme

The European Commission has launched a call for proposals under the 'Capacities' programme of the Seventh Framework Programme (FP7).

The call refers to Activity 6-2-2, which aims to provide support to the bottom up policy coordination initiatives undertaken by several countries and regions. Proposals should address the following policy areas:

- developing an appropriate research and development (R&D) policy mix;
- creating appropriate framework conditions for stimulating private research and development (R&D) investment;
- improving the cooperation and transfer of technologies between public research institutes and private enterprises, including through developing public-private partnerships;
- developing and making better use of incentives to leverage private R&D;
- modernising the management of research institutions and universities;
- enhancing the career development and the European, international as well as intersectoral mobility of R&D personnel.

The response rate to this first call was high, with the Commission receiving nearly 200 proposals. There was a particularly high interest from teams in Central and Eastern Europe and third countries.

EUROBAROMETER: Europeans support greater cooperation with neighbouring countries

A survey conducted for the European Commission by Eurobarometer confirms that a significant majority of people in EU Member States support efforts to intensify co-operation with the countries neighbouring the Union. The overwhelming majority of those polled believe that working with neighbours on fighting organised crime and terrorism, on environment and energy, on economic development, immigration, democracy, education and training is important. Most Europeans believe that EU assistance to its neighbours can serve to extend peace and democracy beyond the borders of the Union, and around half believe that neighbouring countries are indeed willing to co-operate with the EU to introduce internal reforms.

3. News from MPCs

EU-Morocco: Association Council decides to strengthen bilateral relations

The European Commission represented by Eneko Landaburu, the director general for External Relations, and Morocco, represented by Taïb Fassi-Fihri, Minister for Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, took part in the sixth session of the Association Council bringing together the European Union and Morocco, which was held in Brussels. The Association Council discussed the state of bilateral relations between the two partners and ways to instigate a process of reflection on how to strengthen these relations. The European Commission and Morocco used the occasion to sign a joint declaration supporting energy cooperation, notably with a view to preparing for the eventual integration of the Moroccan energy market with that of the European Union. A memorandum of understanding will be signed regarding the support programme for Morocco for the coming years. This will involve more than €650



million and will provide back-up for the implementation of the EU-Morocco Action Plan drawn up under the neighbourhood policy.



Future of Science and Technology in Europe

Portugal, 8-10 October 2007

The European Commission Directorate General for Research and the Portuguese Presidency are organizing a High-level Conference on 'The Future of Science and Technology in Europe' in Lisbon, Portugal to take place from 8 to 10 October 2007 at the premises of the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation.





The topics for plenary sessions include 'Challenges for science and technology in Europe'. 'Promoting and attracting human resources in research', 'Public and private investment in research'. and 'A Vision for the future of S&T in Europe'. Up to nine parallel sessions will also take place covering each of the main issues raised in the Green Paper and some additional cross-cutting topics such as ' ERA Rationales', 'Governance issues and links with Lisbon strategy' and 'Science and Society'. The parallel sessions are expected to bring a substantial input to the work of the European Commission in drawing the main conclusions of the debate on the Green Paper and to prepare concrete proposals for the future. In particular, the first results of independent expert work, which the Commission is currently gathering, will be submitted for discussion in each of the parallel sessions.

The European Union Neighbourhood Policy Conference

Brussels, 3 September 2007

On 3 September, Benita Ferrero-Waldner, Commissioner for External Relations and European Neighbourhood Policy, hosted in Brussels the first ever meeting of Ministers and other representatives from all of the countries covered by the European Neighbourhood Policy (ENP) with their counterparts from the European Union. This international conference: "Working Together – Strengthening the European Neighbourhood Policy", organised and hosted by the European Commission, included a ministerial-level morning session, which focused particularly on the opportunities for trade liberalisation, mobility, and the challenges of climate change and energy security. The afternoon session opened up the debate to other stakeholders including business groupings and non-governmental organisations. The conference was opened by José Manuel Barroso, President of the Commission, Luis Amado, Foreign Minister of Portugal and the current EU Presidency, and Benita Ferrero-Waldner.

EU and Egypt hold joint Committee Meeting on Science and Technology for the first time

Egypt, 20 June 2007

Egypt and the EU held the Joint Committee meeting on Science and Technology for the first time in Egypt on Wednesday, 20th June 2007 at the Smart Village. This was the second Joint Committee meeting of its kind since the signature of the EU/Egypt Science and Technology Co-operation Agreement in Egypt exactly two years previously.

After one year of implementation of the EU/Egypt Science and Technology Agreement, the fruits of co-operation are already bountiful: over 88 Egyptians participated in 70 projects in partnership with EU institutions under the FP6 programme, with a total of €6.6 million. In addition, the establishment of new EU/Egypt Innovation Fund of more than €6 million was recently signed. Furthermore, a network of over 30 focal points was established to disseminate information on FP7 in Egyptian universities, research and technology centres.

Events in Med. Countries

Lebanon, 14 October 200 and 15 November 2007

In the 14th of October, 2007, Dr. Fairouz Sarkis, representing the Lebanese FP7 National Contact Point participated in the meeting of the General Assembly of the Lebanese NGOs, which took place in the premises of the Secretariat General of the Catholic Council for

Patriarchs and Archbishops in Lebanon. Dr. Sarkis, presented an overview of FP7 and pointed out the benefits and opportunities of participation of NGOs in FP7. More than 35

established and prominent NGOs such as Caritas, Arconceil, YMCA, participated in this FP7 workshop. Furthermore, in the 15th of November 2007, the Lebanese FP7 National Contact Point (NCP) and the Faculty of Sciences in the Lebanese University (LU) organized a seminar entitled: "The 7th Framework Program (FP7) and the ICT Priority Theme". The event took place at the LU Hadath science campus and was attended by around 50 ICT specialized researchers. The event was supported by the Dean of the Faculty of Sciences in the Lebanese University, Dr. Ali Mneimneh and representatives of several prominent universities. The Lebanese FP7 National Contact Point (NCP), summarized the 2007-2008 ICT work programme and highlighted the important aspects for the Lebanese research community. Attendees of both events were provided with a folder including FP7 information material and expressed interest for registration to the Lebanese NCP database and the future ERAMED database.

Syria, 7-11 November 2007

The principal exhibition for Syrian Information and communication technology "Shaam 2007" was held in Damascus between 7 and 11 November 2007. HIAST's stand in this exhibition presented many of its activities and projects, particularly general information about FP7, and ERA-MED, PromedAccess, and EumedGrid projects.
