Final Results of the Public Consultation on the Green Paper: "The European Research Area: New Perspectives"

With the <u>Green Paper</u> on the European Research Area (ERA), the European Commission launched a broad institutional and public debate on what should be done to create a unified and attractive European Research Area, which would fulfil the needs and expectations of the scientific community, business and citizens.

The public consultation on the ERA green paper lasted from 1st May 2007 until 31st August 2007. The consultation process was developed in parallel to the discussion with the other institutions. The Commission will use the results of the debate to prepare initiatives that will be proposed in 2008.

The state of the art and possible development perspectives for the Energy Theme in FP7 have been discussed in a **workshop on "Renewable Energy Sources"** in Athens on 15-17



May 2005. As a result of the above mentioned workshop a **Special International Cooperation Activity (SICA)** has been included in the 2007 Energy call of FP7. The SICA focuses on 'Solar irradiation resource assessment and forecasting'. The results should facilitate the matching of different concepts to various solar environments, reduce the cost of integration through improved predictability, and accelerate the rate of solar energy deployment in the EU and neighbouring countries.

The EuroBioForum conference will be held from 17 to 19 September in Strasbourg, France.
