FP7 in Brief

The Seventh Framework Programme (FP7) refers to the next programme in a series of multiannual Framework Programmes that have been the European Union's main instrument for funding R&D since 1984. Programmes have so far been conceived for a period of five years. FP7, however, is proposed for the period 2007-2013. The total European Commission (EC) budget of FP7 is € 53.2 billion. The broad objectives of FP7 have been grouped into four specific programmes: Cooperation, Ideas, People and Capacities. For each type of broad objectives, there is a specific programme corresponding to the main areas of EU research policy. On 4 June 2007, the Commission adopted a decision on the use of lump sum payments for International **Cooperation Partner** Countries (ICPC). This sum covers all the costs of an ICPC participant including the costs for personnel and travel, equipment, consumables and indirect costs. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q1: Is my project idea suitable?

A: The best way to ensure that your proposal is suitable is to study thoroughly the work-program, which explains all the areas/topics that are subject to a call for proposal. Should applicants require any clarification on the content of the work program, they should send their question to the helpdesk, via the Research Enquiry Service.

Q3: Which research topics are supported under the Marie Curie Actions?

A: Proposals from all areas of scientific and technological research of interest to the European Community are accepted and there are no priority areas.

Research fields within the EURATOM program (nuclear fission or fusion) are however not eligible for funding within the Marie Curie schemes.

Q4: Has the terminology in FP7 changed?A: A number of terms have changed to reflect new rules for participation and others to improve clarity and understanding.
